This project includes an update of surgical services, the cardiology unit and the collateral renovation and reallocation of other selected departments to increase the hospital's capacity while integrating and enhancing its existing service lines. This expansion optimizes current operations and establishes a new level of patient care.

The solution expands the hospital 72,200 GSF on five levels to the north, relocating the main entry to the east while tying into the existing circulation system with limited disruption; thus providing an integrating influence between both the exterior and interior elements of the new addition, existing hospital and outpatient clinic. This new entry creates a major orientation node to organize and direct patient flow within the entire facility.

The expansion maximizes natural light where appropriate and takes advantage of the monumental views available from the upper floors and in particular the LDRP rooms. Future expansion of Naval Hospital Bridgeport is still available to the west and satellite locations.
